HOME SWEET HOME

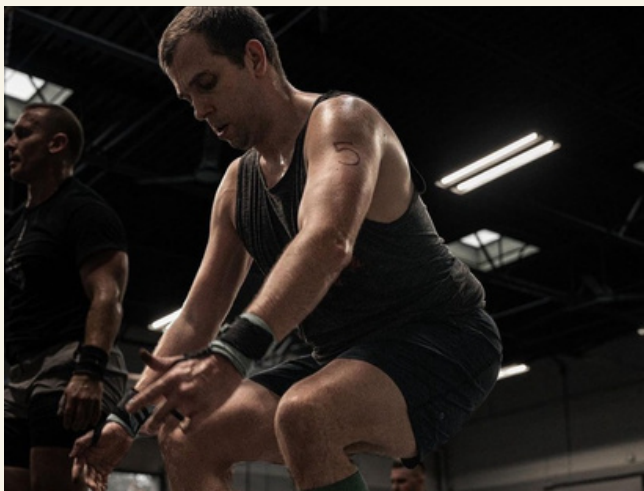

Brendan's younger brothers had classmates who were adopted from China, and he remembers their adoptive mother helping to put on cultural events for their classes, including moon-cakes for the mooncake festival and treats to celebrate Chinese New Year. We both believe that, when it comes to talking about an adoptive child's background, honesty is the best policy. What we plan to do is have age-appropriate conversations, and always emphasize that both the expectant mother and us as adoptive parents love the child unconditionally and want nothing but the best for them.



FAITH



We are both Roman Catholic, go to Mass every week, and have been Catholic our entire lives. It's one of the main reasons that we fell in love and got married, and it's helped us get through various challenges and periods of self-doubt that we've had in our lives.

Brendan almost died twice as a little child due to various illnesses, with one very close call that took place when he was two years old.

He attributes his survival to the fact that this entire family prayed to St. Anthony and the Blessed Virgin Mary to help keep him safe. Brendan went to Catholic school from Pre-K up through college, and was an altar server from 4th grade to 8th grade. Because Sandy works in healthcare, she has seen things that are hard to understand and come to terms with. Being Catholic, and being able to go to Mass and receive the sacraments has helped Sandy to handle the burdens and stress that come with working in healthcare, particularly working in surgery. Should we be chosen as adoptive parents, we will take the child to Mass with us, make sure they receive the sacraments and do our best to show them how to live a kind and virtuous life.

CELEBRATIONS & TRADITIONS

We both love to celebrate Christmas and Easter, Sandy loves to celebrate Halloween, and Brendan enjoys Memorial Day. We will spend time with family and friends, and bring our dog Calvin with us whenever possible. For Christmas, we will see both of our families for Christmas meals and presents, and we'll either go to mass on Christmas Eve with Brendan's family or Christmas Day by ourselves. We'll end the night by watching Muppet Christmas Carol. For Easter, we go to Mass and then go to Easter Brunch with Brendan's family. We typically see Sandy's family the day before, where we will put on Easter Egg hunts for our niece and nephew. For Halloween, we always make sure our house has plenty of treats and decorations. Sometimes, we'll meet up with Sandy's brother's family and help our nephew and niece trick or treat. We bring our dog Calvin with us sometimes and it's cute to watch our nephew and niece, who are still very young, play with and pet him.
